Authors will be notified regarding the acceptance of their abstracts after reviewing. Full papers are due by **September 18th, 2013**. Final acceptance of full papers will be notified by **October 29th, 2013**.

Publication

The Conference proceedings will be published by an international publisher and will be distributed at the Conference to registered participants. Extended versions of selected papers presented at the Conference will be considered for publication in **Structure and Infrastructure Engineering - Maintenance, Management, Life-Cycle Design & Performance**, an international peer-reviewed scientific journal endorsed by IABMAS, and included in the ISI Science Citation Index (http://www.tandf.co.uk/journals/nsie).
